What's the Difference?

JVSD-Owned Program

- An MOU exists between the JVSD and the partner school regarding funding and expenditures (FTEs, equipment, furniture, employee salary, etc)
- Teacher is an employee of the JVSD
- The JVSD assigns a supervisor to oversee the program
 - Responsible for teacher evaluation, program funding and compliance for Quality program review

Partner School-Owned Program

- Teacher is an employee of the partner school
- The partner school has all responsibility for program funding, data & compliance

What if my school district already has a Career Tech Program, can we have a Satellite program too? Can they Co-Exist?

Best Practices for A Successful Partnership

Communication is Key!

- **From the superintendents to instructors, it is important to build an open line of communication**
- **When issues arise, make sure you know who the contact person is so that they can work through the issue or concern**

Best Practices for A Successful Partnership

Willingness to help each other

- **MVCTC has provided professional development to Miamisburg staff to assist them with QPR and Perkins**
- **Miamisburg has assisted MVCTC satellite programs with transportation, billing and parent communication**
- **Support programs by attending events or activities**

Best Practices for A Successful Partnership

Scheduling

- **Communicate the difference between Satellite and Miamisburg programs**
- **Work with school counselors to know scheduling parameters**
- **Make sure students know what they are taking when they register**

Best Practices for A Successful Partnership

Marketing

- Market relationship between Partner District and CTPD as a partnership
- Meet with counselors to explain programming
- Create flyers for distribution
- Attend parent meetings
